### **Traffic Issues - Riverview Road - Ongoing issues**

During the Winter months the traffic congestion at our Riverview Road entrance is heavy and often very dangerous. Many of our young children use this exit and have a tendency to hurry out of the gate, often they are not visible to traffic. That is why we have yellow lines at the end of the road for no parking.

**Please do not park in driveways or on the yellow lines to collect your children. A short walk is safer than putting our children at risk.**

Auckland Council will be monitoring this entrance and tickets will be issued to those failing to follow the rules for safe parking. We have been given a reference number to quote and a contact email should you wish to report any dangerous parking (see below). Please include the number plate and colour/make of car. If you can take a photo that would also be helpful. We need to stop this dangerous activity before a child is seriously injured or killed.
