Lunches will cater for the diet, health and cultural needs of our students, and we will work with suppliers and the Ministry of Education to make sure they are healthy and nutritious. Mufti Day- This Friday!

As a school community, we are wanting to show our support to one of our students Vinuga Sooriyaarachchi, his mum Buddhini and his 7-month-old brother Vinuth. On the 4th of February, they sadly lost their father/husband Jeevaka to a heart attack. He was fit and healthy so this was a complete shock to the family and their world was turned upside down. In July 2021, Jeevaka and his family would have been eligible for permanent residency. However, Buddhini, Vinuga and Vinuth are no longer eligible for permanent residency and have excessive legal fees to pay to resolve this issue. On top of this Jeevaka was the sole income earner.

Thankfully one of Buddhini's friends set up a Give a Little Page at <u>https://givealittle.co.nz/cause/lets-make-this-family-happy</u> to help them meet the numerous costs associated with living and gaining a residence visa until Buddhini is able to return to work.
