A big welcome back to all of our families. We have had a slow start to our level 2 return to school with 50% of students attending so far this week.

The teachers and support staff have been actively promoting safe practices in our school such as safe distancing and hand sanitisation. So far everyone is doing a great job and the children are responding well to the changes around the school.

Our classroom programmes are being delivered in full and learning is well underway here at school. As a result the online teaching will no longer be taking place.
