Keeping Ourselves Safe - Parent Information Meeting - It was great to hear we had a big turnout of parents/caregivers at our Keeping Ourselves Safe parent information meeting yesterday afternoon. Senior Constable Carl talked through the reasons behind the programme and what is taught as part of Keeping Ourselves Safe. Many of those who attended asked for more information about how best to keep their children as safe as possible when they are using internet-connected devices at home. Netsafe is a Ministry of Education supported online internet safety organisation that provides resources, advice and support for those in need. They have a great online safety parent toolkit (available for download in English, Te Reo, Samoan, Chinese and Tongan) that is a great resource for navigating these issues, they highly recommend taking an educational approach before restricting access.
