## **Attendance Update**

Many families and children have had a difficult time with a big increase in colds and flu so early in the year. We are hoping the winter months will not be as harsh as time away from school has a significant impact on learning progress.

80% attendance equates to 2 days absent a fortnight and we are aiming to improve this to 90% across the school for all year levels. So far our rates of attendance for 2024 are-

Year 1 - 83% attendance Year 3 - 87% attendance Year 5 - 87% attendance Year 6 - 90% attendance
