From the Desk of the Principal:

I would like to begin by informing all members of our school community that our school is about to receive a significant upgrade to the classroom interiors. This work will commence

on Monday 4 August and will initially involve Rooms 1-4 in our senior block. Following on from this there will be work to the other senior classrooms and then the junior rooms which will continue for the remainder of this school year.

The upgrade is taking place in stages and 4 classrooms will be forced to relocate at each stage. Initially the following rooms will be moving to the following classes-

Room 1 will be moving to Room 5

Room 2 will be moving to Room 18

Room 3 will be moving to Room 8

Room 4 will be moving to Room 16



Although some of these senior classes will be in the junior area of the school the students will still be playing in the senior playground area.

The building areas will be fenced off however there should be no issues with access to the school site.

This work is long overdue and we are looking forward to starting 2026 with much improved learning environments.


